Maybe we'll soon have six of them, and it takes a lot of funds. But recently we passed the 2000th baby that we have helped through the Adopt-a-Birth program. I have been collecting the pictures again, and the number for 2016 will be even greater than last year. When the pictures arrive at my office, I like to imagine what those kids are saying or thinking, and it comes out as "baby talk"! I hope you will remember them and us in prayer, too, as we remember you every day!

Fr Inosensius in Indonesia has been writing me and sending me information about the housing needs for seminarians. The building there is being planned for 100 students. If they are there for six years of schooling, that comes to about 16 seminarians per year. Won't it be wonderful to be able to ordain sixteen priests a year! Wow! We are praying for it! Maybe you have already received a mailing from me from our office in California. It gives a lot of the details. This year we couldn't take any new seminarians in Indonesia because there was no space—Our buildings were completely

full! We don't want a repeat of that for next year! So we need to act now.

Actually, I need to write this letter a few days in advance because FOCUS is arriving on July 15 for their annual tour of our work in the Russian Far East. This year we had a FOCUS group touring our work in Indonesia, too. We are sure grateful for their interest in our work, and I'm sure it is good for the FOCUS students to see the Church at work in these (for them) "far away places." They also don't fail to give good examples to our young people.
